Circuit n°1 : Barbentane - Graveson



«Into the heart of la Montagnette»

Come and discover the culture and heritage of Provence while cycling through an emblematic spot of Terre de Provence :
The hills of La Montagnette.



	Distance	Time	Degree of Difficulty
Short Circuit (1a)	15 km	1H30	Easy
Long Circuit (1b)	30 km	4H00	Difficult

Along the way, look for and follow the road signs seen below :

- 1-From the starting point in front of City Hall, turn left and ride down to the main street.
- 2-At the "stop" sign, go straight onto the street named "Rue du Rhône".
- 3- At the roundabout, turn left onto "Rue de la Durance".
- 4-Next, turn left onto D35.
- 5- Carry on for approximately 20 metres and turn right on to "chemin de l'Esplantade". which eventually turns into a dirt trail.
- 6-Turn right at the little bridge and take "Chemin des Lonnés".
- 7-At the intersection, turn left on to "chemin du mouton". Continue straight ahead until you arrive at the embankment alongside the Rhône River. Aramon and la ViaRhôna will be on your left.
- 8-Turn right on to the paved road if you wish to continue the circuit.
- 9-Go on until you see the barrier for the "Déchetterie" (household rubbish). Then, take a right onto « chemin de la Sainteté ».
- 10- Once you are passed the first crossroads, turn right onto « Chemin de la Ramière ».
- 11- At the roundabout, follow the road-signs towards Rognonas on the road D34 for approximately 500 metres.
- 12- At the Hôtel Castel Mouisson sign, turn right onto « Chemin sous les Roches ».

2 possible options :

To do the short circuit (15 km) :

- 13- Turn right on the « Route des Carrières » and continue straight ahead.
- 14b- At the "stop" sign, turn right on the road D35e.
- 22-Turn right onto the « chemin des Moulins » where you can take time during a stopover at the Angelica Tower before riding under the stone arch on the street « Rue de Séquier ».
- 23-Take the first right on a street called « rue de la Caradone ». Be careful ! Steep descent !
- 24- End point: arrive in front of the church « Notre Dame de Grace ». Take the stairs behind the church and enjoy the panoramic view. Take « chemin rue Pujade » on your left to reach the City Hall,

To do the long circuit (30km) :

- 13-Turn left onto « Route des Carrières ».
- 14-At the crossroads, turn right onto the « Route de Terrefort ».
- 15-Go straight until you arrive at the crossroads of the departmental (green itinerary). Turn right.
- 16-Continue for about 800 metres and follow the trail on your right. Continue on « Chemin Saunier ».
- 17- In order to reach Graveson city centre, turn left on « Chemin des Areniers ». Otherwise, continue straight ahead until the roundabout of Cadillan.
- 18-Take the first exit on the D930 and go ahead for 500m.
- 19-Turn right « chemin de la Juverte » where you will ride under a little tunnel.
- 20- Turn left on the « Traversée de la Juverte » after the little ascent of the road. Turn right on the D81. Go straight ahead for 5 km after the Abbaye de Frigolet. To finish the circuit, n°22.

Along the way, you also will find artisans and their work and local producers listed in the brochure « Guide des Découvertes » available at the Tourist Board of Terre de Provence and Tourists Offices and city-halls of each town.
